Year 10 Focus: Work Experience Readiness

How to: Add a work experience placement to the placements tool

All work experience details, health and safety checks, and employer approvals must be logged digitally on Unifrog. This step-by-step guide walks students through entering their employer details correctly so the approval process runs smoothly.

The CV / Resume tool

The Writing tool
